Water - 4 to 5 times a day at 15 minute intervals or enough to insure that the turfgrass and soil beneath are kept thoroughly moist. Do not flood it or let it set in water. Do this for the first 10 days or until your new grass is firmly established. After the first 10 days, cut watering back to three or four times a week, depending on weather: If you see a blue gray silver haze on your new lawn, it is an indication of not receiving enough water.
